## ***Vision and Objectives of Alrowwad:***

Alrowwad (Pioneers for Life) cultural and arts society (ACTs) was established in Aida refugee camp-Bethlehem in 1998 to promote and celebrate life and inspire hope and to give children and youth every potential to live for their country and defend their rights. Alrowwad, initiator of “Beautiful Resistance,” is an independent, dynamic, community-based not-for-profit organization which strives to empower children and women by targeting behavior, knowledge, concepts and practices through creative and non-violent means.

## ***Vision:***

1. A Palestinian Society free of violence and respectful of human rights and values, in which women, youth and children are empowered on an educational and artistic level in a spirit of social entrepreneurship and innovation through self-expression and a shared respect of human values and rights.
2. Be one of the premiere institutions for the training in performing and visual arts in Palestine.

## ***Mission:***

ACTS is an independent Palestinian organization, distinguished by its philosophy of “Beautiful Resistance,” working in the spirit of social entrepreneurship, to deepen the notion of belonging, volunteering, creativity and self-expression for children, youth and women, regardless of origin or religion. ACTS partner with kindergartens, schools and the local community to create a harmonious and unified society using and employing beautiful and peaceful expression through education as well as performing and visual arts to preserve Palestinian identity and oral history. Moreover, ACTS provides vocational training for job creation and building the peace within individuals to be able to build it among Palestinians and the world.

Alrowwad was established in 1998, with the belief that everybody is important and everyone is a change maker. ACTS believes that Palestinian tragedy is political and works with the philosophy “With or without money, we do it” to promote active support to create jobs and build infrastructure and support Palestinians to do what they need to do. ACTS develops its pioneering programs with local and international partners according to the needs and priorities of Palestinian community and capacity building of the organization and its employees through

specialized trainings to develop the infrastructures, using modern technology for human communication in diffusing its programs and activities, building bridges of partnerships and exchange locally and internationally, based on respect of human rights and values and Palestinian specificity, and conserving tradition and environment. Beautiful Resistance against the ugliness of occupation and violence

Alrowwad expands its activities and artistic tours and range of beneficiaries starting from Aida refugee camp to Bethlehem, to include marginalized and poorly served villages and refugee camps and areas in different governorates in Palestine. Alrowwad artistic shows and films have toured locally and internationally in Europe, UK and USA. We work hardly on developing partnerships in the Arab world and East Asia. Alrowwad pioneered by creating the first professionally trained children theatre troop in West Bank, the first outdoor film festival, the first Palestinian folktale festival, the first sports for social change program for women in a refugee camp, the first images for life program (professional photography and video training in Palestinian refugee camp, the first student scholarships fund and providing services and activities with reasonable cost. Alrowwad is a member of Ana Lindh network, partner with Ashoka and Synergos, Palestinian Justice Network and Palestinian Refugees Network.



### ***Mandate - target group:***

ACTS targets the Palestinian community while focusing on women, youth and children in the local community of Aida Camp and the Bethlehem district. Additionally, ACTS targets the international community at large to break stereotypes and project a real image of Palestine and Palestinian people and culture. ACTS strives to have full capacity to mobilize human, technical and financial resources to achieve positive, dynamic, effective and long lasting change.

### ***Developmental Objectives:***

1. Empower local community capacities, with a focus on children, youth and women through creative means to achieve and enhance constructive and peaceful ways of self-confidence and self-expression, openness and a sense of belonging through exposure to technology and literacy coupled with the conservation of indigenous knowledge and human values using specialized training and awareness campaigns.

2. Challenge media stereotypes about Palestinians using performing and visual arts, Media, international artistic tours, local and international “Friends of Alrowwad” support groups.
3. Build the institutional and human capacity of Alrowwad.

### *Specific Objectives:*

1. Raise the artistic, cultural and social level of members and target group of children, youth and women.
2. Participate in developing and building local theater, culture, artistic media and educational segments in Palestine.
3. Paying attention to raise the awareness toward human rights issues including those of children, women and youth, and deepen their spirit of belonging and giving to develop their sense of creativity.
4. Give children and youth of the Palestinian families the chance to build bridges of

cultural and social exchange and channels of communications with people of other countries.

5. Carry on workshops in computer, story writing and storytelling, artistic workshops and other educational training courses that would develop the capacities of target group from various ages.

6. Promote the active learning and establish a specialized library in theatre, arts, literature and culture.

7. Promote the cultural links between cultural institutions, writers and actors in Palestine and abroad through regular meetings.

8. Establish a training center and a audio visual platform for children and youth.

## *Outputs:*

1. Improve the image of the Palestinian people and culture.
2. Improve self-expression, confidence and knowledge of children and women in the camp
3. Deepen the sense of belonging and belief in a better future
4. Enhance networking and cultural exchange locally and internationally based on human values and non-violence.
5. Establish a permanent institution with qualified staff and experts based on human rights and mutual respect.

## *General Conditions in Alrowwad:*

ACTS is seeking to make a positive and long lasting change and develop the capacities of its participants in the working units. Alrowwad was successfully able to achieve many objectives, make positive impact among its participants and partners by offering a healthy atmosphere to evacuate their stress, express themselves in beautiful and creative ways. Alrowwad has worked in 2015 on expanding its work and serving marginalized areas, schools and kindergartens to respond to the degradation in potentials of expression and development. Alrowwad activities covered regions from south Hebron to north of Jenin.

Alrowwad received more than 1911 visitors and delegations from 10 different countries. ACTS carried on 339 activities in 50 Palestinian areas. ACTS programs and activities benefitted 26,280 including 12,610 females and 13,670 males from age 5 and above in kindergartens, schools, community institutions, children centers and charities.
